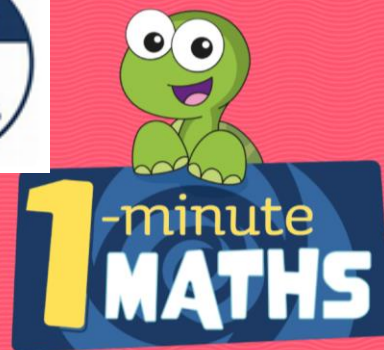
Unasha, Elise, Phillippa, Reggie, Darcey-Mae, Rosie Ding and Rosie Charles have received their Silver Award, da iawn!
