Universal Primary School Meals programme

Since September, all children in reception classes across Wales have been able to have free meals at school, and from April Universal Primary Free School Meals will be rolled out to all year 1 and 2 pupils in Wrexham as well. This is the second stage of the Welsh Government's response to the rising cost-of-living pressures on families, tackling child poverty and ensuring no child goes hungry in school. The same offer will be available to years 3 to 6 from September 2023.

Does your child already receive Free School Meals?

If your child currently receives Free School Meals based on your circumstances, you may also be entitled to additional help through the Pupil Development Grant, which includes financial support for uniform, sports equipment and devices. To access this year's scheme click <u>here</u> So, as the summer term approaches, we are urging parents to apply for the support they're entitled to. Has your financial situation changed in the last year? If your child is not currently receiving Free School Meals, but your circumstances have changed this year, Wrexham might have support available for you. To check if you are eligible for Free School Meals, visit Free school meals | Wrexham County Borough Council. If you are eligible, you may also be able to receive the Pupil Development Grant.

Parent Pay Account

You need to pre-order on Parent Pay. This really helps your child's school because teachers aren't spending time taking orders. It also means your child gets their first choice of meal and helps us reduce waste. Once you are set up on Parent Pay, you'll be able to book your children's meals up to two weeks in advance
