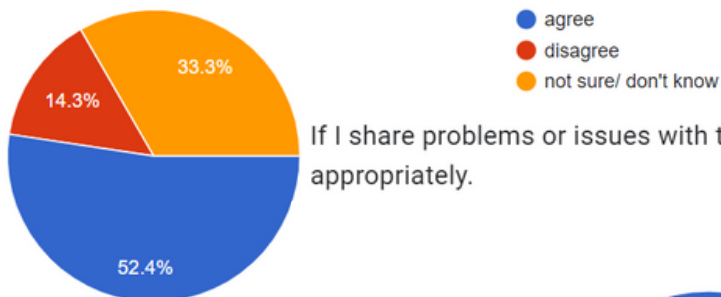


Look at our improvement journey so far.

These are the last two pieces of comparative data and I thank you for your honest feedback over the year and ask for your trust in the direction set for the future. Diolch pawb!

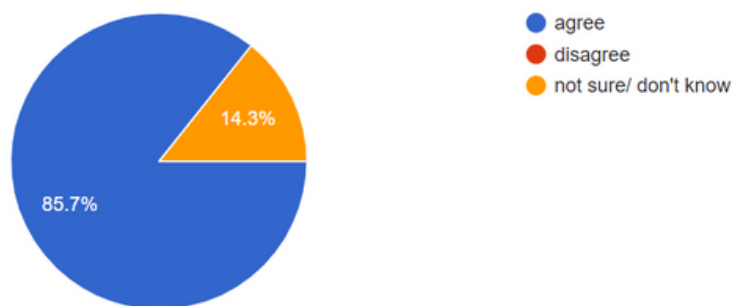

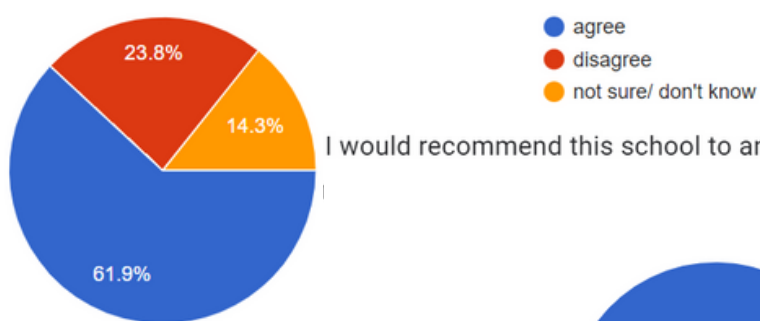

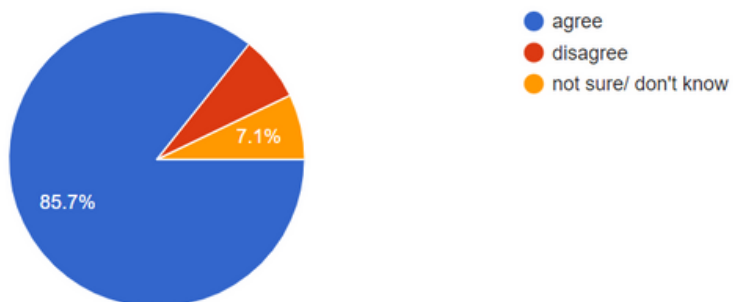
