### **Universal Primary Free School Meals scheme rolls out to Years 3 to 6**

If your child will be starting in years 3 to 6 in September in primary school, you'll want to read this! Children in reception classes and years 1 and 2 across Wales are already receiving free school meals thanks to the Welsh Government's Universal Primary Free School Meals programme, and from September this will be rolled out to all years 3 to 6 pupils in Wrexham. This is the part of the Welsh Government's response to the rising cost-of-living pressures on families, tackling child poverty and ensuring no child goes hungry in school.

Don't miss this opportunity to get a hot nutritious school meal for your child – for free!

Does your child already receive Free School Meals?

If your child currently receives Free School Meals based on your circumstances, you may also be entitled to additional help through the School Essentials Grant, which includes financial support for uniform, sports equipment and devices.

So from September we are urging parents to continue apply for Free School Meals so that your child receives the maximum support that they're entitled to.
