We are really grateful to James for giving up his time to speak to us. He has promised to speak to us again on his return and share his experiences, challenges and photographs.





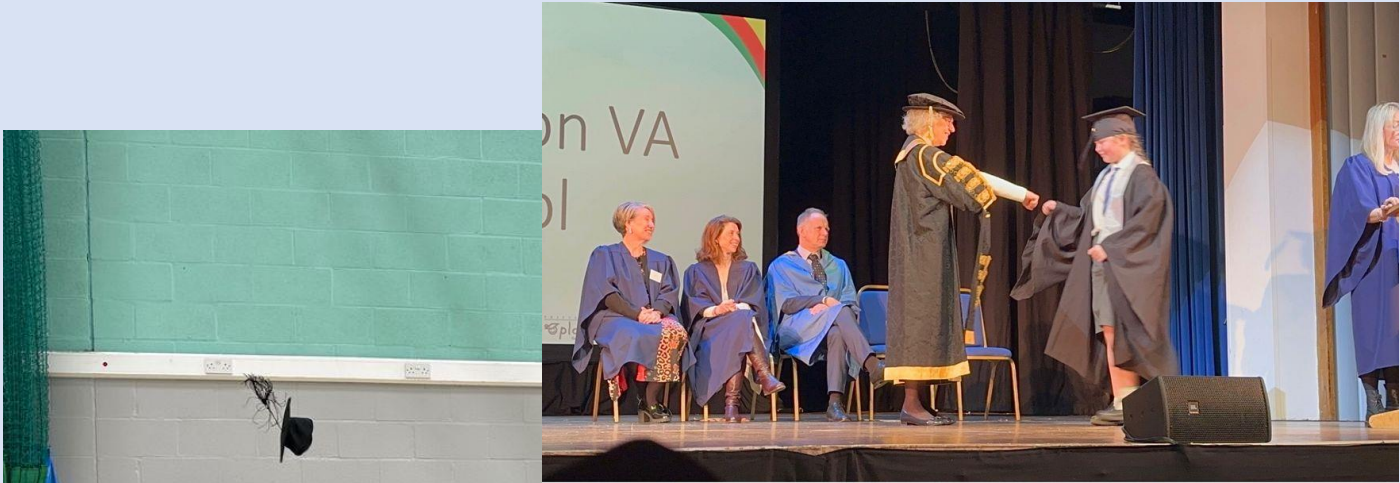
We were really fortunate this week to meet real life Welsh explorer James McCorkindale who is about to embark on an expedition to the Arctic!

This term Bumblebees are learning about 'People who help us' this week we have been looking at Doctors and Nurses and how they can help us if we are hurt or poorly.




