Guide Dogs

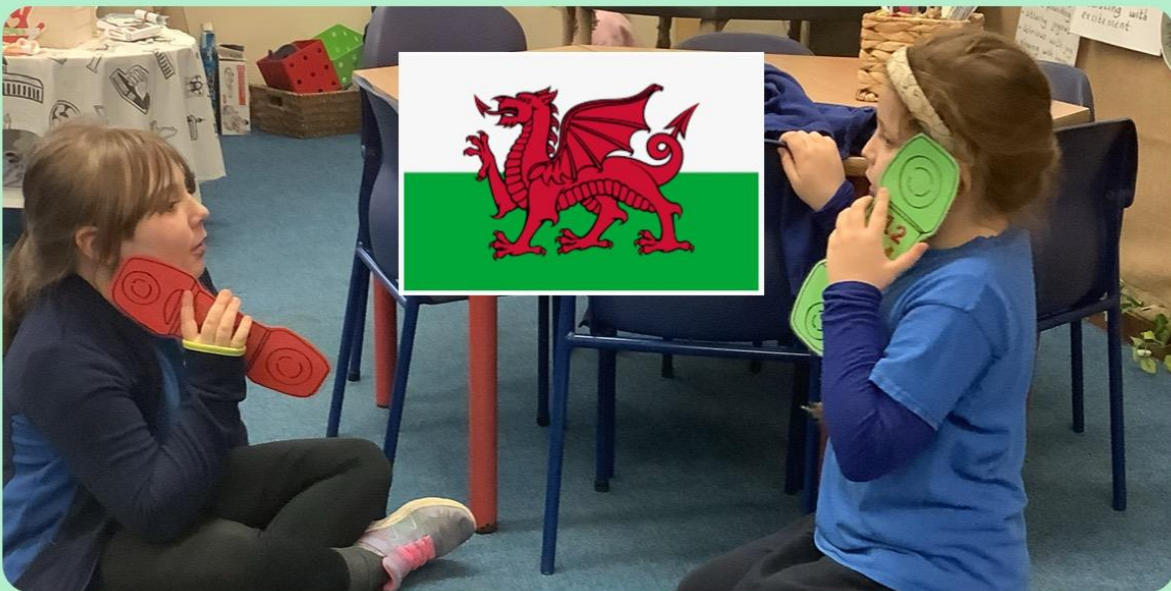

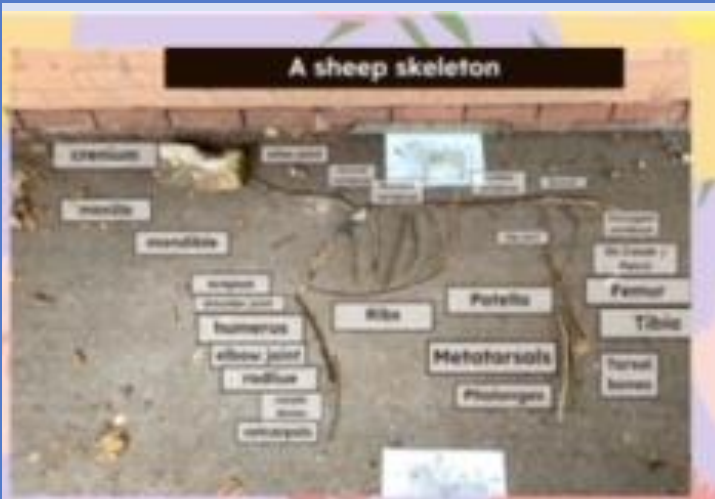

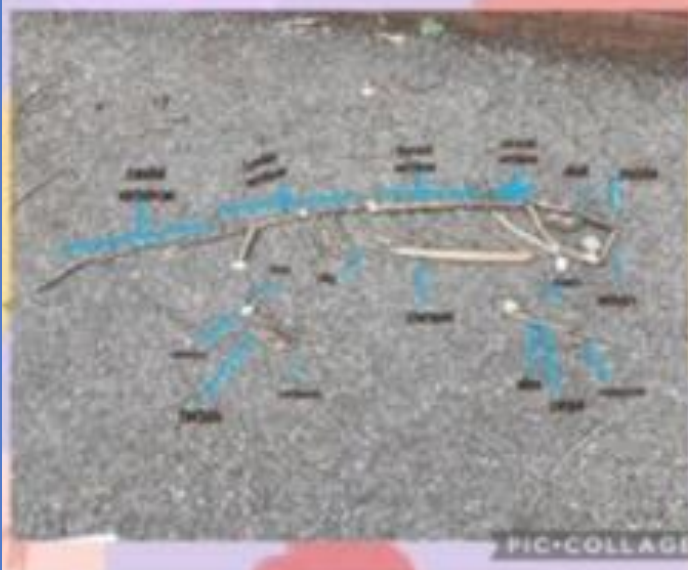




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CREATING ANIMALS SKELETON IN THE OUTDOOR AREA
