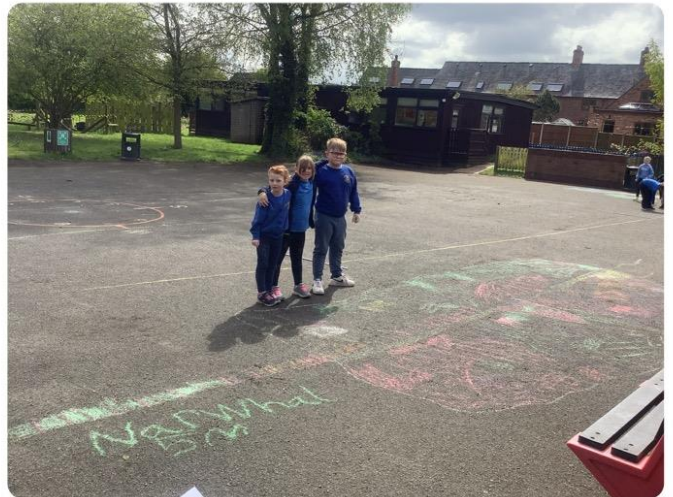

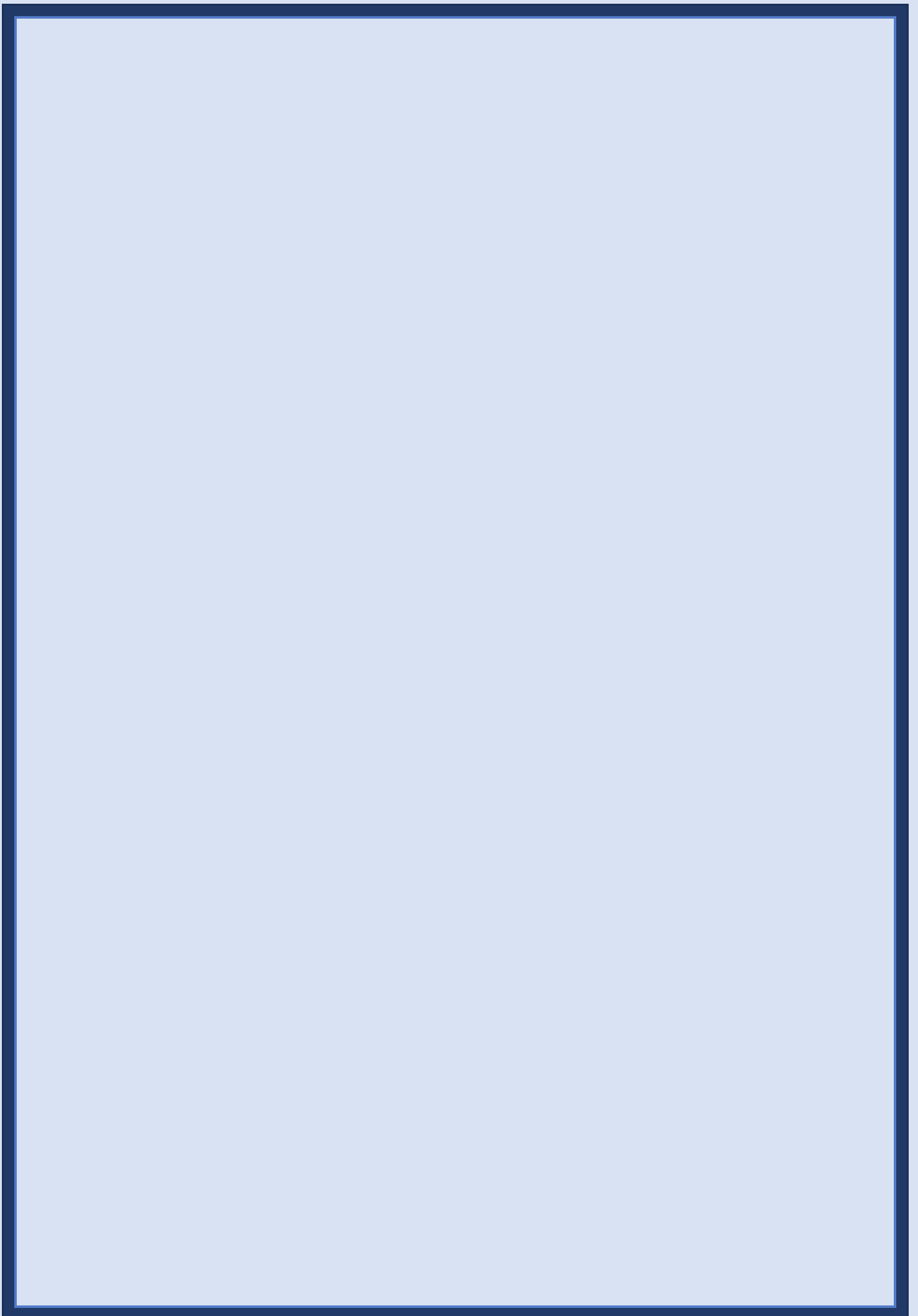






Finally, we checked out the rock pools and the octopus!
