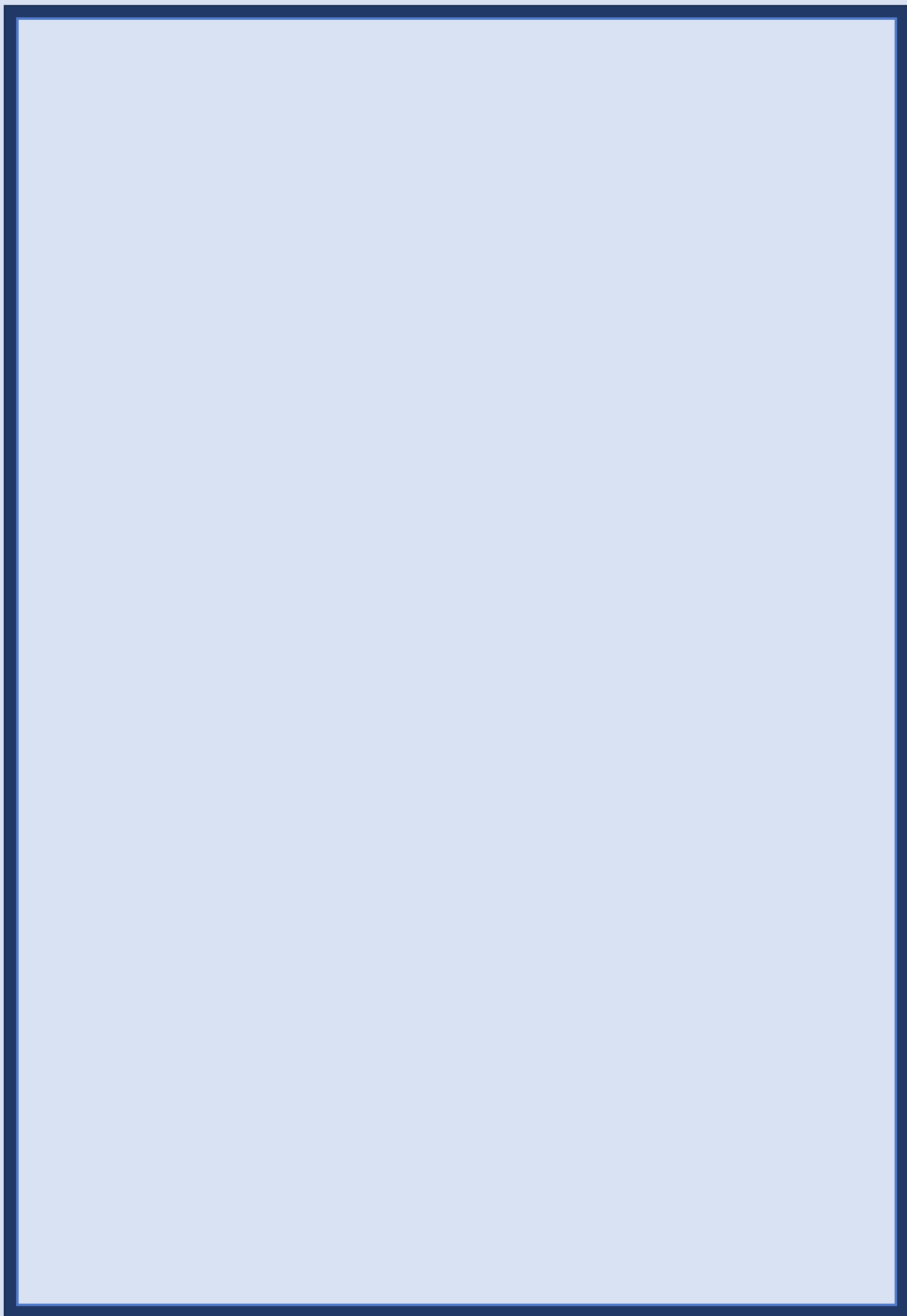

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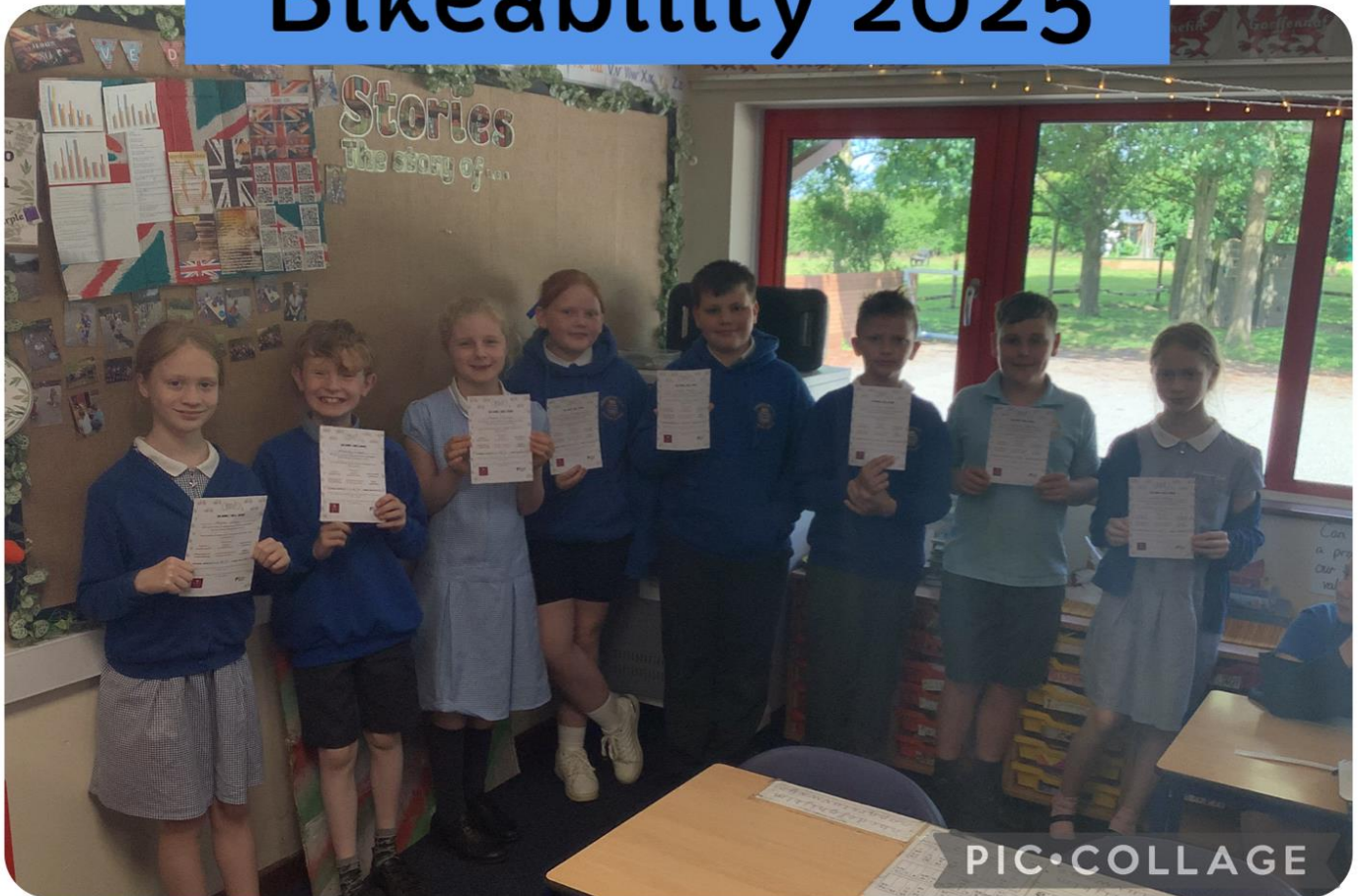
Congratulations to Sophia who received her Reading award recently. There's still time to earn yours before the end of the year, so get reading at home.
